POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

Student Advisors provide the student voice to the Board of Directors and serve as full voting members of the Board. They also chair the important Student Leadership Committee. Student Advisors must be student members of active chapters and must be willing advocates for the needs and concerns of the student members of Sigma Tau Delta. Together, the two Student Advisors work to promote the goals of the Society among its members.

Applications for the position should include the following:

- a letter of intent to run, with a statement of qualifications,
- a wallet-sized photo or recent snapshot that can be trimmed to 2¼"x 3",
- a summary of Sigma Tau Delta chapter involvement,
- a one-page *Curriculum Vitae*, and
- a one-page recommendation from the local faculty sponsor **sent by separate mail.**

All these materials should be postmarked by *February 10, 2010.*

Candidates for the **Student Advisor** position will be interviewed and appointed by the Board of Directors. Individuals will assume their offices at the 2010 International Convention.
